Ratings for Coaches, Players and Sidelines

Rating scale:

- 1 = Poor
- 2 = Below average
- 3 = Average
- 4 = Above average
- 5 = Outstanding

Note: Three (3) ratings will be given to each team by the referee as follows: one for the coach, one for the players and one for the sidelines.

Some of the attributes to rate team coach's behavior on:

- a. Treatment (pos / neg) of his or her team players (opponents as well)
- b. Coaches behavior (pos / neg) towards referee officials and their calls
- c. Coach's end of the game behavior (hand shakes, comments, parking lot, et...)
- d. Team roster sheets properly filled out.
- e. Treatment (pos / neg) of opponents (coaches, players and parents)
- f. Treatment (pos / neg) of assistant referees

Some of the attributes to rate team players behavior on:

- a. Pre-game behavior
- b. Treatment / behavior (pos / neg) towards opponents (players).
- c. Treatment / behavior (pos / neg) towards opponents sidelines.
- d. Treatment / behavior (pos / neg) towards referee officials.
- e. Treatment / behavior (pos / neg) towards own teammates.

Some of the attributes to rate each teams sideline behavior on:

- a. Are they under control?
- b. Treatment / behavior (pos / neg) towards their own team players and their opponents.
- c. Treatment / behavior (pos / neg) towards referee officials
- d. Treatment / behavior (pos / neg) towards assistant referees (if provided)
