#### Subj: Aug 2019 VP of Comp Report

- 1. Small Sided Referee and the RMA requirement.
  - a. All Clubs have followed through with SSReferee training. We must now be diligent to follow through with acquiring RMA certification for those referees
- 2. We have several expected changes that have been approved by the Ruling Body of FIFA. The outcome of these decisions has filtered down from FIFA to USSF and ultimately WYS.
  - a. We have met with KPSRA and have been provided for the application of the information provided by Washington Soccer Referee Committee.
  - b. The proposals make good sense.
  - c. Some, I am not seeing benefit at the Recreation level.
  - d.NSYSA must make decisions on what are exceptions to these rules and then record those exceptions within our Operating procedure.
    - i. I believe the only exception NSYSA has considered as an exception is the location that the player leaves the field for substitution.
    - ii. Changes to the Law are a function of FIFA and documented in the Laws of the Game. US Soccer translates the law changes and issues a document.
    - iii. WYS and WSRA issued a clarifying paper. This is the document that should be shared with the coaches and used.
    - iv. To copy all the laws and changes is cumbersome, may cause conflict if transcribed incorrectly, and mandates a yearly change.
  - e. This is why it is my recommendation that we remove the laws of the game entirely and only list the exceptions we, as an Association, choose to apply.
- 3. The NSYSA 2019 Fall Soccer Season scheduling meeting was held 17 August. a.Schedules are beginning to populate.
  - b. Please have coaches look at their schedules for the first couple weeks. If there are discrepancies, please notify the Club Assignor.
  - c. Changes for convenience sake are the lowest priority.

- 4. Please ask coaches to print schedules early. Ensure that all staff is listed on the roster and all players are listed. Team rosters can be updated with jersey numbers prior to the first game.
- 5. Some Clubs have rosters with 1 or 2 more players than normal. This was done to consider allowing more players play. In nearly all cases the player is of age or a play up.
- 6. Please review WYS rules for playdown requests. All playdowns must have WYS CEO, Terry Fischer approval, prior to placing the player on the roster.
- 7. Clubs looking to assign players down to a younger team due to medical reasons or physical handicap issues must apply to WYS and receive approval before they may assign the player to a team.
  - a. A copy of the approved documents from WYS must be provided to NSYS Registrar.
- 8. Some thoughts on the new changes:
  - a. Throw Ins Opposing team must stand 2 yards off the touchline so as not to interfere with the thow in.
  - b. Goal Kicks The opposing team must remain outside of the penalty area until the ball is touched by a second member of the same team. The opposing team may then enter the penalty area and challenge the ball.
  - c Drop Kick Only the team member for the team last in possession of the ball will participate in the drop kick.

Subj: September 2019 VP of Comp Report

- 1. I have read many referee reports where coaches have not provided rosters at the field. As we all are aware, it is the priority of all Clubs, Association, and WYS to provide a safe environment for our kids.
  - a. The roster is the one secure means of doing so.
  - b. Fortunately, through the committed work of our NSYSA Website Administrator we now have rosters which represent staff members from both teams.
  - c. Sideline Conduct U05 thru U10, parents and spectators SHALL remain on the opposite side of the field away from the teams.
  - d. Some Clubs have chosen to make a minor exception to this rule.
    - i. For U05 & U06, coaches may be present on the field. From U07 and above all coaching shall be from the touchline.
    - ii. For U05 & U06, Parents may be on the side with the team. But all parents must be outside of the technical area of the team. From U07 and above all none rostered individuals must be on the opposite touchline of the team.
- 2. I have instructed KPSRA that without rosters to identify team staff only **one** coach may remain on the team sideline during the game.
  - a. The roster is the only verification of proof available to ascertain individual completion of the RMA process. Since the coach chooses not to bring such proof to the field, all un-identified staff must remain on the parents' side.
- 3. Some Clubs have rosters with 1 or 2 more players than normal. This was done to consider allowing more players play. In nearly all cases the player is of age or a play up.
  - a. A player must be a printed named player of a roster to play with the team. No handwritten additions are allowed.
- 4. NSYSA has received no notifications of playdown for this 2019 2020 Soccer season. Therefore, all team rosters should reflect players of age.



- 5. NSYSA has received no notification of play up for players playing two years greater than their current age.
  - a. It is NSYSA policy that players playing greater that one year above their birth age be evaluated for ability to be successful at the higher age level and a statement from the Club Coaching Director/VP of Competition be submitted stating so.
- 6. I would like to congratulate all the Clubs who held clinics and supported the training of a new class of referees.
  - a. The first two weeks of referee assignments where 95% plus successful.
  - b. With the third weekend of games, the percentages dropped slightly.
  - c. And with this coming week, KPSRA assignor says we are returning to having to hunt and scratch for enough referees to do all the games.
- 7. I have read many coaches reports that are derogative to the referee.
  - a. Are we talking about the young referee that is doing his first game?
  - b. Is it not hard enough for them to be out there performing a task that so many others would never do?
- 8. Why are we letting our parents be destructive of the job they do?
  - a. And yes, I have read those reports from the referees and opposing coaches.
  - b. I have read the comments that never want that referee again.
  - c. Please reread report item #6 above.
    - i. Is this kind of treatment taking its toll?
- 9. We have a finite number of experienced referees. They are a largely sought-after resource.
  - a. High School games take them in numbers. And those games command three-man teams.
  - b. School events, as the school season goes on, will draw down the number of available referees.
  - c. Referees deciding that they need not be treated poorly have just left.
- 10. These young referees are our tomorrow. They are the resource pool of the future.
  - a. Is the decision to send them away after having been disrespected and criticized?



- 11. If you have problems with a referee, notify your Club officers.
  - a. In turn, Clubs notify your Association.
  - b. In accordance with the KPSRA contract only the Association Officer may bring these kinds of issues to the Referee Association.
- 12. Recreation Cup registration is coming to an end fast. October 31<sup>st</sup> is the registration closure date and roster freeze.
- 13. There have been reports of nets that have not been secured. Please be responsible to secure nets by some means of support.
